Bike Ability Balance

Bike Ability Balance is a new initiative to encourage children in reception and year 1 to take to two wheels. I am pleased to announce that St Mary's is one of the first schools in Cornwall to offer this programme to all pupils in reception and year 1.

There are a series of sessions which involve lots of fun and games using balance bikes (bikes without pedals). Evidence shows that children learn to ride bikes much quicker this way than by using bikes with stabilisers.

We have a class set that will be stored in a mobile trolley, this will ensure that all pupils across the school have access to them on a regular basis.
