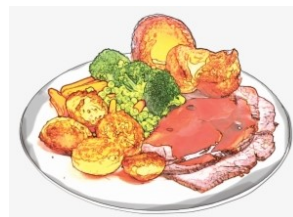
### TERRACYCLE

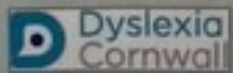
